SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT 1999 DECLARATION OF LOCAL-INTAKE AREAS FOR SCHOOLS WITH PRIMARY STUDENTS (PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 60, 78, 79 AND 80)

The Hon. Minister for Education has declared that the local-intake areas for the schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas stated shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

ARBOR GROVE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for this school—

From the junction of Gnangara Road and Pinaster Parade, north and north east along Pinaster Parade to The Promenade, east along The Promenade to the most easterly point on the proposed section of this road (as shown in the 2004 StreetSmart Street Directory), north from this point to the proposed section of The Broadway, east and north along the proposed section of The Broadway to the locality boundary between Ellenbrook and The Vines, generally north along the locality boundary between Ellenbrook and The Vines to Maralla Road, west along Maralla Road to the proposed Perth Darwin Highway, south and south west along the proposed Perth Darwin Highway to Gnangara Road and east along Gnangara Road to Pinaster Parade. The boundary parts of Pinaster Parade (north west side), The Promenade (north side), The Broadway (both sides) and Gnangara Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Maralla Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Arbor Grove Primary School and Upper Swan Primary School—

From the junction of West Swan Road and Millhouse Road, south west along West Swan Road to the locality boundary between Belhus and Ellenbrook, north along this locality boundary to the dam at Coruna Park, north west from the dam to the western end of Millhouse Road, north from the western end of Millhouse Road to a point on the locality boundary between Ellenbrook and The Vines nearest the southern end of Taittinger Grove), west, north, west and north along this locality boundary to Maralla Road, east along Maralla Road to the railway line, south east along the railway line to the locality boundary between The Vines and Upper Swan, west and south along this locality boundary to Ellen Brook, south and west along Ellen Brook to Millhouse Road and south along Millhouse Road to West Swan Road. The boundary parts of West Swan Road (north side) and Millhouse Road (both sides) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Maralla Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

BICTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake of this school—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Stock Road, west south west along Canning Highway to Whittle Court, north along Whittle Court to Birdwood Circus West, north along Birdwood Circus West to Birdwood Circus, north along Birdwood Circus to Phipps Street, north along Phipps Street to the northern end of that street, north west from the northern end of Phipps Street to the Swan River foreshore, north east and east along the Swan River foreshore to the northern extension of Stock Road, south along this extension and continuing south along Stock Road to Canning Highway. The boundary parts of Canning Highway (north side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary parts of Whittle Court (both sides), Birdwood Circus West (both sides), Birdwood Circus (both sides), Phipps Street (both sides) and Stock Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

Students resident in the boundary part of Stock Road (both sides) are entitled to attend either Bicton Primary School or Attadale Primary School.

The following defines an optional area between Bicton Primary School and Attadale Primary School—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Stock Road, north along Stock Road to Preston Point Road, south east along Preston Point Road to Canning Highway, and west south west along Canning Highway to Stock Road. The boundary parts of Preston Point Road (south west side) and Canning Highway (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Bicton Primary School and Richmond Primary School—

From the intersection of Petra Street and Canning Highway, east north east along Canning Highway to Whittle Court, north along Whittle Court to Birdwood Circus West, north along Birdwood Circus West to Birdwood Circus, north along Birdwood Circus to Phipps Street, north along Phipps Street to the northern end of that street, north west from the northern end of Phipps Street to the Swan River foreshore, south west along the Swan River foreshore to the northern extension of Petra Street, south along this extension and south along Petra Street to Canning Highway. The boundary parts of Canning Highway (north side), Whittle Court (both sides), Birdwood Circus West (both sides), Birdwood Circus (both sides), Phipps Street (both sides) and Petra Street (east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Bicton Primary School and Palmyra Primary School—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Stock Road, south along Stock Road to Hammad Street, west along Hammad Street to Petra Street, north along Petra Street to Canning Highway and east north east along Canning Highway to Stock Road. The boundary parts of Stock Road (west side), Hammad Street (both sides), Petra Street (east side) and Canning Highway (south side) are included within this optional area.

BEELIAR PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Beelihar Drive and Tindal Avenue, south along Tindal Avenue to Fancote Avenue, east along Fancote Avenue to Henderson Road, south along Henderson Road to Russell Road, south east along Russell Road to a point due south of the centre of Kogolup Lake, north from this point on Russell Road through Thompsons Lake and Kogolup Lake to Beelihar Drive, west along Beelihar Drive to Tindal Avenue. The boundary parts of Beelihar Drive (south side) and Russell Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area for Beelihar Primary School. The boundary parts of Tindal Avenue (both sides), Fancote Avenue (both sides) and Henderson Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

BUSHY GROVE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following will define the local-intake area of this school when it opens in 2007—

From the junction of Nicholson Road and Garden Street, south and south east along Garden Street to Clipper Parade, south west along Clipper Parade to Gateway Boulevard, north west along Gateway Boulevard to Barents Road, south west along Barents Road to Bering Promenade, south east along Bering Promenade to Becher Avenue, south west along Becher Avenue to Shreeve Road, continuing south west across the public open space to the junction of Katrine Parade and Cannich Boulevard, south and south west along Katrine Parade to Amherst Road, north west along Amherst Road to Fraser Road North, south west along Fraser Road North to Birnam Road, north west along Birnam Road to Nicholson Road, north east along Nicholson Road

to Garden Street. The boundary parts of Garden Street (south west side), Gateway Boulevard (east side), Barents Road (both sides), Katrine Parade (north side), Amherst Road (north east side), Fraser Road North (north west side), Birnam Road (north east side) and Nicholson Road (south east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Clipper Parade (both sides), Bering Promenade (both sides) and Becher Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

BUSSELTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the coastline of Geographe Bay, south along Queen Street to Causeway Road, south east along Causeway Road to Bussell Highway, east along Bussell Highway to Vasse Highway and south east along the Vasse Highway to Sabina Road, north east along Sabina Road to Banksia Road, east along Banksia Road to Hithergreen Road and north east along Hithergreen Road to Claymore Road. The boundary streets of Queen Street (east side), Causeway Road (east side), Bussell Highway (north side), Vasse Highway (east side), Sabina Road (north side), Banksia Road (north side) and Hithergreen Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

CALISTA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for this school—

From the junction of Wellard Road and Parmelia Avenue, north along Parmelia Avenue to Challenger Avenue, west along Challenger Avenue to Gilmore Avenue, north along Gilmore Avenue to a point coinciding with the southern arm of Leasham Way, west from this point to and along Leasham Way to Summerton Road, west along Summerton Road to Stanyford Way, north along Stanyford Way to Gentle Road, west along Gentle Road to Tasker Road, west along Tasker Road to the railway line, south along the railway line to Wellard Road and east south east along Wellard Road to Parmelia Avenue.

The boundary parts of Wellard Road (north side), Challenger Avenue (both sides) and Gilmore Avenue (west side) are included within the area for Calista Primary School, while the boundary parts of Parmelia Avenue (both sides), Leasham Way (both sides), Stanyford Way (both sides), Tasker Road (both sides), Gentle Road (both sides) and the boundary street of Summerton Road (both sides) are excluded from the area for Calista Primary School.

The following defines an optional area for Calista Primary School and Orelia Primary School—

From the junction of Gilmore Avenue and Challenger Avenue, east along Challenger Avenue to Parmelia Avenue, north along Parmelia Avenue to Sulphur Road, west along Sulphur Road to Gilmore Avenue and south along Gilmore Avenue to Challenger Avenue. The boundary parts of Sulphur Road (south side) and Gilmore Avenue (east side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Parmelia Avenue (both sides) and the boundary street of Challenger Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

The following defines an optional area between the following primary schools - Calista, Forrestdale, Medina, North Parmelia and Orelia—

From the junction of Anketell Road and Thomas Road, south west along Thomas Road to the locality boundary between Anketell and Oakford, north along this locality boundary to Anketell Road and east along Anketell Road to Thomas Road. The boundary parts of Anketell (south side) are included within this optional area, and the boundary parts of Thomas Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between the following primary schools - Calista, Medina, North Parmelia and Orelia—

From the coastline of the Indian Ocean at a point coinciding with the westerly extension of Hope Valley Road, east from this point to and along Hope Valley Road to Rockingham Road, south east along Hope Valley Road and its south east extension to the junction of Anketell Road and McLaughlan Road, east along Anketell Road to the locality boundary between Anketell and Oakford, south along this locality boundary to Thomas Road, generally west along Thomas Road to Rockingham Road, due west from this point to the coastline of the Indian Ocean and north along the coastline to the westerly extension of Hope Valley Road. The boundary parts of Hope Valley Road (south side), Anketell Road (south side) and Thomas Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

EXCELSIOR PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following will define the local-intake area of this school when the primary school located at Bushy Grove, Canning Vale, opens in 2007—

From the junction of Amherst Street and Katrine Parade, south east along Amherst Road to the intersection with Campbell Road, south through the public open space and lakes - with the following three streets on the east - Corsham Gardens, Ladham Turn, Welbeck Road and Repton Loop, and the following two streets on the west - Prior Close and Sandringham Promenade- to the intersection of Sandringham Promenade and Welbeck Road, south east along Sandringham Promenade to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Ranford Road, south east along Ranford Road to Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to the locality boundary between Huntingdale and Southern River, north west along the locality boundary to the junction of Garden Street and Warton Road, north west along Garden Street to Clipper Parade, south west along Clipper Parade to Gateway Boulevard, north west along Gateway Boulevard to Barents Road, south west along Barents Road to Bering Promenade, south east along Bering Promenade to Becher Avenue, south west along Becher Avenue to Shreeve Road,

continuing south west across the public open space to the junction of Katrine Parade and Cannich Boulevard, south and south west along Katrine Parade to Amherst Road.

The boundary parts of Amherst Road (north east side), Corsham Gardens (both sides), Ladham Turn (both sides), Welbeck Road (both sides), Repton Loop (both sides), Warton Road (south east side), Ranford Road (north east side), Southern River Road (north west side), Garden Street (west side), Clipper Parade (both sides), Gateway Boulevard (west side), Bering Promenade (both sides), Becher Avenue (both sides) and Katrine Parade (south east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Prior Close (both sides), Sandringham Promenade (both sides) and Barents Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

FORRESTFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary between Forrestfield Primary School and Woodlupine Primary School is defined as follows—

From the intersection of Tonkin Highway and Hale Road, in a general northeasterly direction along Hale Road to Hawtin Road and north north east along Hawtin Road to Sultana Road East. The boundary parts of Hale Road (south and south east sides) and Hawtin Road (east side) are included within the area for Forrestfield Primary School.

The following defines an optional area for Forrestfield, Dawson Park and Woodlupine Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Tonkin Highway and Hale Road, northeast along Hale Road to Cypress Road, northwest along Cypress Road and its extension to Roe Highway, southwest along Roe Highway to Tonkin Highway, and southeast along Tonkin Highway to Hale Road. The boundary parts of Hale Road (north west side), Roe Highway (south east side) and Tonkin Highway (north east side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary street of Cypress Road (both sides) is excluded from the optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Maida Vale Primary School and Forrestfield Primary School—

From the junction of Holmes Road and Maud Road, west along Maud Road to Hawtin Road, south along Hawtin Road to Sultana Road East, east to Holmes Road and north along Holmes Road to Maud Road. The boundary parts of Maud Road (south side), Hawtin Road (east side) and Holmes Road (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Wattle Grove Primary School and Forrestfield Primary School—

From the junction of Welshpool Road East and Lewis Road, north east along Lewis Road to Palm Terrace, south east along Palm Terrace to the picnic area at Lesmurdie Brook, south from the picnic area to Welshpool Road East and generally west along Welshpool Road East to Lewis Road. The boundary parts of Palm Terrace (both sides) and Welshpool Road East (north side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Lewis Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

GEOGRAPHE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake of this school—

From the junction of Hithergreen Road and Claymore Road, south west along Hithergreen Road to Banksia Road, west along Banksia Road to Sabina Road, south west along Sabina Road to the Vasse Highway, north west along Vasse Highway to Bussell Highway, west along Bussell Highway to Causeway Road, north west along Causeway Road to Queen Street, north along Queen Street to Albert Street, west along Albert Street and continuing west along Bussell Highway to the drainage channel, south along the drainage channel beside Queen Elizabeth Avenue to the New (Broadwater) River, west along the New (Broadwater) River to Fairway Drive, south along Fairway Drive to the Busselton Bypass, east along the Busselton Bypass to Queen Elizabeth Avenue, south along Queen Elizabeth Avenue to Don Road and south along Don Road to Evans Road. The boundary parts of Hithergreen Road (south side), Banksia Road (south side), Sabina Road (south side), Vasse Highway (west side), Bussell Highway (eastern section, south side), Causeway Road (west side), Queen Street (west side), Albert Street (south side), Bussell Highway (western section, south side), Fairway Drive (east side), Busselton Bypass (north side), Queen Elizabeth Avenue (east side) and Don Road (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

GREENMOUNT PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the bridge at the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Buninyong Road, north east along Buninyong Road to Innamincka Road, north west along Innamincka Road to Buckingham Road, east along Buckingham Road to Amherst Road, north along Amherst Road to Beresford Gardens, east along Beresford Gardens to Mulberrytree Close, south along Mulberrytree Close to the locality boundary between Greenmount and Swan View, east along the locality boundary between Greenmount and Swan View to the junction of Swan View Road and Wandu Road, east along Wandu Road to Sunset Hill Road, east along Sunset Hill Road to the locality boundary between Greenmount and Hovea, south, east and south along the locality boundary between Greenmount and Hovea to Great Eastern Highway, west along Great Eastern Highway to a point on the southern extension of Stirling Road, due south from this point to Convict Creek, west and south west along Convict Creek to the footpath on the south eastern extension of Coongan Avenue, north west from this point to the south eastern end of Coongan Avenue, north west along Coongan Avenue to Scott Street, north along Scott Street to Great Eastern Highway and north west along Great Eastern Highway to Buninyong Road.

The boundary parts of Roe Highway (east side), Welshpool Road (western section, north side), Tonkin Highway (southern section, east side), Welshpool Road (eastern section, south side) and Tonkin Highway (northern section, west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Wattle Grove Primary School and East Kenwick Primary School—

From the bridge carrying Welshpool Road over the railway line, south east along the locality boundary between Kenwick and Wattle Grove, continuing north east and south east along this locality boundary to Boundary Road, north east along the extension of Boundary Road to Tonkin Highway, south east along Tonkin Highway to the locality boundary between Kenwick and Maddington, south east along this locality boundary to Bickley Road, north west along Bickley Road to the railway line and north along the railway line to Welshpool Road. The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (west side) are included within this optional area, and the boundary parts of Bickley Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Wattle Grove Primary School and Orange Grove Primary School—

From the junction of Crystal Brook Road and Gavour Road, south west to the northernmost point of the locality boundary between Wattle Grove and Orange Grove, south east along this locality boundary to the locality boundary between Wattle Grove and Lesmurdie, north east, north west and north east along this locality boundary to Welshpool Road East, generally west along Welshpool Road East to the junction of Welshpool Road East and the extension of Schofield Road, south from this junction to the junction of Crystal Brook Road and Gavour Road. The boundary parts of Welshpool Road East (south side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Wattle Grove Primary School and Forrestfield Primary School—

From the junction of Welshpool Road East and Lewis Road, north east along Lewis Road to Palm Terrace, south east along Palm Terrace to the picnic area at Lesmurdie Brook, south from the picnic area to Welshpool Road East and generally west along Welshpool Road East to Lewis Road. The boundary parts of Palm Terrace (both sides) and Welshpool Road East (north side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Lewis Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

WEST BUSSELTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the coastline of Geographe Bay, south along Holgate Road and its extension to and along the eastern north-south boundary of Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass, east along the Busselton Bypass to Fairway Drive, north along Fairway Drive to the New (Broadwater) River, east along the New (Broadwater) River to the drainage channel, north along the drainage channel to Bussell Highway, east along the Bussell Highway and continuing east along Albert Street to Queen Street, north along Queen Street to Geographe Bay, and west along the coastline of Geographe Bay to the northern extension of Holgate Road. The boundary parts of Holgate Road (both sides), the Busselton Bypass (north side), Fairway Drive (west side), the drainage channel (west side), Bussell Highway (north side), Albert Street (north side) and Queen Street (west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass is excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

WOODBIDGE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake of this school—

From the Swan River (near the Woodbridge historic house), south along the locality boundary between Guildford and Woodbridge to the railway line, west along the railway line to its junction with the north-south railway line at a point just west of the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline Corridor, south along the railway line to Great Eastern Highway Bypass, east along Great Eastern Highway Bypass to Roe Highway, north along Roe Highway to Bushmead Road, west along Bushmead Road to Military Road, north along Military Road to Clayton Street, north west along Clayton Street to Lloyd Street, north along Lloyd Street to Great Eastern Highway, west along Great Eastern Highway to Helena Street, north along Helena Street to the Old Great Northern Highway, north east along the Old Great Northern Highway and its north easterly extension across Midland Square to the junction of Great Northern Highway and Morrison Road,

west along Morrison Road to Elvire Street, north along Elvire Street to the locality boundary between Viveash and Woodbridge, west along the locality boundary between Viveash and Woodbridge to the Swan River, south and west along the Swan River foreshore to the locality boundary between Guildford and Woodbridge.

The boundary parts of Great Eastern Highway Bypass (north side), Roe Highway (west side), Bushmead Road (south side), Great Eastern Highway (south side), Helena Street (both sides), Old Great Northern Highway (west side), Morrison Road (both sides) and Elvire Street (both sides) are included within the local-intake area for Woodbridge Primary School. The boundary parts of Military Road (both sides), Clayton Street (both sides) and Lloyd Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for Woodbridge Primary School.

The following defines an optional area between Woodbridge Primary School and Midvale Primary School—

From the junction of Great Northern Highway and Morrison Road, west along Morrison Road to Elvire Street, north along Elvire Street to the locality boundary between Viveash and Woodbridge, west along the locality boundary between Viveash and Woodbridge to the Swan River, north and east along the Swan River to a point on the north west extension of Bassett Road, south east along this extension and south east along Basset Road to Great Northern Highway and south along Great Northern Highway to Morrison Road.

The boundary parts of Basset Street (both sides) and Great Northern Highway (west side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Morrison Road (both sides) and Elvire Street (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

YANGEBUP PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of North Lake Road and the railway line, south east along North Lake Road to the junction with Osprey Road, south from this junction through Yangebup Lake to Beeliar Drive, west along Beeliar Drive to Spearwood Avenue, north along Spearwood Avenue to the junction with Yangebup Road, continuing north along the proposed northern extension of Spearwood Avenue to the railway line and north east along the railway line to North Lake Road. The boundary parts of North Lake Road (west side), Beeliar Drive (north side) and Spearwood Avenue (east side) are included in this local-intake area.

SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT 1999

DECLARATION OF LOCAL-INTAKE AREAS FOR SCHOOLS WITH SECONDARY STUDENTS

(Pursuant to Sections 60, 78, 79 and 80)

The Hon. Minister for Education has declared that the local-intake areas for the secondary schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas of the following secondary schools shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. The local-intake area of a secondary school may be defined in this notice by listing the names of the contributory primary schools, the local-intake areas and the traditional catchment areas of which, when amalgamated, constitute the local-intake area of that secondary school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

BALCATT A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools : Balcatta, Takari, West Balcatta and Yuluma, the traditional catchment areas of Lake Gwelup and Osborne Primary Schools and the following exception.

Children resident within the traditional catchment area of Osborne Primary School and resident in Main Street (both sides) and west thereof are entitled to attend Balcatta Senior High School Children resident within the traditional catchment area of Osborne Primary School and resident in the area east of Main Street are entitled to attend either Balcatta Senior High School or Mirrabooka Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Carine Senior High School and Balcatta Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Mitchell Freeway and the Reid Highway, south along the Mitchell Freeway to Erindale Road, east along Erindale Road to Boya Way, south along Boya Way to Odin Road, south along Odin Road and its extension to the Mitchell Freeway, south and south east along the Mitchell Freeway to a point due east of the southern arm of Birrale Loop, west from this point between the southern arm of Birrale Loop and Hertha Place to Odin Road, south along Odin Road to Barnes Street, west along Barnes Street to Huntriss Road, north along Huntriss Road and its northern extension through Lake Karrinyup to North Beach Road, west along North Beach Road to Okley Road, north along Okley Road to the Reid Highway and east along the Reid Highway to the Mitchell Freeway. The boundary parts of the Mitchell Freeway (both sections, west side), Erindale Road (south side), Boya Way (south side), Odin Road (east of Freeway section, west side), Birrale Loop (southern arm, both sides), Odin Road (west of Freeway section, west side), Barnes Street (north side), North Beach Road (north side) and Reid Highway (south side) are included with this optional area. The boundary parts of Hertha Place (both sides), Huntriss Road (both sides) and Okley Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster and Balcatta Senior High School—

From the intersection of Sackville Terrace and Holbeck Street, east along Sackville Terrace and Barnes Street to Odin Road, north along Odin Road to the southern arm of Birrale Loop, east between the southern arm of Birrale Loop and Hertha Place to the Mitchell Freeway, south and south east along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road, north west along Scarborough Beach Road to Holbeck Street and north along Holbeck Street to Sackville Terrace. The boundary parts of the Sackville Terrace (south side), Barnes Road (south side), Odin Road (east side), Hertha Place (both sides), Mitchell Freeway (west side) and Scarborough Beach Road (north side) are included with this optional area. The boundary parts of Birrale Loop (both sides) and Holbeck Street (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

BELMONT CITY COLLEGE

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of Belmont and Cloverdale Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of Belmay, Redcliffe and Tranby Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area of Belmont City College—

From the overpass of Victoria Park Drive and the Graham Farmer Freeway, south east along the Graham Farmer Freeway to Orrong Road, continuing south east along Orrong Road to Kewdale Road, north east along Kewdale Road to Tonkin Highway, continuing north along Horrie Miller Drive and its extension to the local government authority boundary (City of Belmont and Shire of Swan), north-west along the local government boundary to Great Eastern Highway, south-west along Great Eastern Highway to Ivy Street, north-west along Ivy Street to the Swan River foreshore, south, south-west and west along the Swan River foreshore to a point due east of the overpass at Victoria Park Drive and the Graham Farmer Freeway and west to this overpass. The boundary parts of the Graham Farmer Freeway (north east side), Orrong Road (north east side), Kewdale Road (north west side), Great Eastern Highway (east side) and Ivy Street (both sides) are included within the area for Belmont City College.

The following defines an optional area between Belmont City College and Kent Street Senior High School—

From the overpass of Victoria Park Drive and the Graham Farmer Freeway, south east along the Graham Farmer Freeway to Orrong Road, continuing south east along Orrong Road to Kewdale Road, south along Kewdale Road to Welshpool Road, west along Welshpool Road to the railway line, north west along the railway line to the Belmont Park railway station, and north east to the overpass of Victoria Park Drive and the Graham Farmer Freeway. The boundary parts of the Graham Farmer Freeway (south west side), Orrong Road (south west side), Kewdale Road (west side) and Welshpool Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

CAPE NATURALISTE COLLEGE

The local-intake area of this proposed secondary school will be defined by the traditional catchment areas of Dunsborough Primary School and Vasse Primary School.

The following will define a partial boundary between Cape Naturaliste College and Busselton Senior High School—

From the coastline of Geographe Bay, south along Holgate Road and its extension to the eastern north-south boundary of Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass, east along the Busselton Bypass to Queen Elizabeth Avenue, south along Queen Elizabeth Avenue to Don Road, and continuing south to Evans Road. The boundary parts of the Busselton Bypass (south side), Queen Elizabeth Avenue (west side) and Don Road (west side), and Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass, are included within the local intake area of Cape Naturalist Secondary College. The boundary street of Holgate Road (both sides) is excluded from the local intake area of this school.

The following will define an optional area between Cape Naturaliste College and Busselton Senior High School—

The local-intake area of West Busselton Primary School.

CARINE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From a point on the Indian Ocean coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive, east from this point to the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive, north east along West Coast Highway to Karrinyup Road, east and south east along Karrinyup Road to Huntriss Road, north along Huntriss Road and its northern extension through Lake Karrinyup to North Beach Road, west along North Beach Road to Okley Road, north along Okley Road to the Reid Highway, east along the Reid Highway to the Mitchell Freeway, north along the Mitchell Freeway to Warwick Road, west along Warwick Road to Marmion Avenue, south along Marmion Avenue to Freeman Way, west along Freeman Way to High Street, and west along High Street and its extension to the Indian Ocean, and south along the coastline to a point on the Indian Ocean coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive.

The boundary parts of West Coast Highway (north side), Karrinyup Road (north side), Huntriss Road (both sides), North Beach Road (south side), Okley Road (both sides), Reid Highway (north side), Mitchell Freeway (west side), Warwick Road (south side), Marmion Avenue (east side), Freeman Way (south side) and High Street (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Carine Senior High School and the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster—

From a point on the Indian Ocean coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive, east from this point to the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive, north east along West Coast Highway to Karrinyup Road, east and south east along Karrinyup Road to Huntriss Road, south along Huntriss Road to Barnes Street, west along Barnes Street to Holbeck Street, south along Holbeck Street to Scarborough Beach Road, north west and west along Scarborough Beach Road and its western extension to the coastline and north along the coastline to a point on the coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive. The boundary parts of West Coast Highway (south side), Karrinyup Road (south side), Huntriss Road (both sides), Barnes Street (both sides), Holbeck Street (both sides) and Scarborough Beach Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Carine Senior High School and Balcatta Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Mitchell Freeway and the Reid Highway, south along the Mitchell Freeway to Erindale Road, east along Erindale Road to Boya Way, south along Boya Way to Odin Road, south along Odin Road and its extension to the Mitchell Freeway, south and south east along the Mitchell Freeway to a point due east of the southern arm of Birrale Loop, west from this point between the southern arm of Birrale Loop and Hertha Place to Odin Road, south along Odin Road to Barnes Street, west along Barnes Street to Huntriss Road, north along Huntriss Road and its northern extension through Lake Karrinyup to North Beach Road, west along North Beach Road to Okley Road, north along Okley Road to the Reid Highway and east along the Reid Highway to the Mitchell Freeway. The boundary parts of the Mitchell Freeway (both sections, west side), Erindale Road south side), Boya Way (south side), Odin Road (east of Freeway section, west side), Birrale Loop (southern arm, both sides), Odin Road (west of Freeway section, west side), Barnes Street (north side), North Beach Road (north side) and Reid Highway (south side) are included with this optional area. The boundary parts of Hertha Place (both sides), Huntriss Road (both sides) and Okley Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

COMET BAY COLLEGE

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Baldivis, Endeavour, Secret Harbour, Singleton, Settlers.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Mandurah Road and Ennis Avenue, north along Mandurah Road to Millar Road, east and north east along Millar Road West to Wellard Road, generally east along the locality boundary of Baldivis to the bridge over the drain near the junction of Mundijong Road and Duckpond Road, south along the drain to a point due north of the junction of Karnup Road and Yangedi Road, south along Yangedi Road to Henderson Road, west along Henderson Road and its westward extension to the Serpentine River, south along the Serpentine River to the southern boundary of the locality of Karnup, west along the southern boundary of the locality of Karnup to Mandurah Road, continuing west across Mandurah Road and along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to the Indian Ocean coastline, north along the coastline to a point due west of the most north westerly point of Antonio Circuit, east from this point on the coastline to the north west corner of Antonio Circuit, east between Antonio Circuit and Knutsford Crescent, then east keeping the following streets in brackets all on the north (Tryall Avenue, Belmont Close, Trafalgar Gardens, Nunton Place, Rueval Court and Benbecula Loop) and keeping the following streets in brackets all on the south (Majestic Close, Bounty Court, Bingarra Close, Nautilus Close, Ceri Close, Galley Close and Batavia Court), and continuing east to Warnbro Sound Avenue, south along Warnbro Sound Avenue to Port Kennedy Drive, east along Port Kennedy Drive to Ennis Avenue and south along Ennis Avenue to Mandurah Road.

The boundary parts of Mandurah Road (east side), Millar Road West (both sides), Yangedi Road (both sides), Henderson Road (both sides), Warnbro Sound Avenue (west side), Port Kennedy Drive (south side) and Ennis Avenue (west side) are included within the area for Comet Bay College.

The following defines an optional area between Comet Bay College and Mandurah High School—

From the coastline of the Indian Ocean, east along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to Fremantle Road, south along Fremantle Road to a point on the easterly extension of the proposed George Hibbert Road, west from this point on Fremantle Road along the easterly extension of George Hibbert Road, west along George Hibbert Road, and west along its westerly extension to the coastline, north along the coastline to the locality boundary of Madora Bay and Singleton. The boundary parts of Fremantle Road (west side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of George Hibbert Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Comet Bay College and Armadale Senior High School—

From the junction of Duckpond Road and Mundijong Road, west along Mundijong Road to the locality boundary between Baldivis and Oldbury, north west along this locality boundary and continuing east and north east along the locality boundary between Oldbury and Wellard to the railway line, east along the railway line to a drain, south south east along the drain to the Birraga Main Drain, south and south west along the main drain to Mundijong Road and west

along Mundijong Road to Duckpond Road. The boundary parts of Mundijong Road (north side) are included in this optional area.

COMO SECONDARY COLLEGE

The local-intake area of this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Collier and Como Primary Schools, and the traditional catchment areas of Curtin, Manning and Wilson Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the Shelley Bridge, north east along Leach Highway to Manning Road, east along Manning Road to a point due south of the southern extension of Hill View Terrace, north along this extension and Hill View Terrace to Walpole Street, north east along Walpole Street to Holder Street, west along Holder Street to Maquis Street, south west along Marquis Street to Hayman Road, generally north west along Hayman Road to South Terrace, west along South Terrace to the Swan River foreshore, south along the Swan River foreshore and continuing south along the Canning River foreshore, and east along the Canning River foreshore to the Shelley bridge. The boundary parts of Leach Highway (north west side), Manning Road (south side), Hill View Terrace and extension (west side), Walpole Street (north west side), Holder Street (south side), Marquis Street (south east side), Hayman Road (south west side) and South Terrace (south side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Como Secondary College and Kent Street Senior High School—

From the junction of Douglas Avenue and South Terrace, north west along Douglas Avenue and its north westerly extension to the Swan River foreshore, north west and south along the Swan River foreshore to a point on the westerly extension of South Terrace, east along this extension and east along South Terrace to Douglas Avenue. The boundary parts of Douglas Avenue (south west side) and South Terrace (north side) are included within this optional area.

FORRESTFIELD SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools : Edney, Forrestfield, High Wycombe, Maida Vale and Woodlupine, the traditional catchment areas of Dawson Park and Wattle Grove Primary Schools, and the following exceptions.

Children from Wattle Grove Primary School are entitled to attend either Forrestfield Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestfield and Kalamunda Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass and the railway line, east along the Great Eastern Highway Bypass to the Roe Highway, north along the Roe Highway to Bushmead Road, east along Bushmead Road to the boundary between the Shires of Mundaring and Swan, south east along the shire boundary to Ridge Hill Road, south and south west along Ridge Hill Road to Watsonia Road, south, south east and south west along Watsonia Road to Kalamunda Road, south east along Kalamunda Road to Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way to the walk trail, west along the walk trail to West Terrace, north west and north along West Terrace to Simeon Close, west along Simeon Close and its extension to Maud Road, and continuing west along Maud Road to Hawtin Road, north along Hawtin Road to Kent Road, west along Kent Road to Brewer Road, south along Brewer Road to Bruce Road, west along Bruce Road to Sultana Road East, north west along Sultana Road East to Sultana Road West, continuing north west along Sultana Road West to Milner Road, south west along Milner Road to the boundary between the localities of Forrestfield and High Wycombe, west along this locality boundary to the local government boundary between the City of Belmont and the Shire of Kalamunda, north, north west and north east along the Shire of Kalamunda boundary to the railway line and north along the railway line to the Great Eastern Highway Bypass. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (south side), Roe Highway (east side), Bushmead Road (south side), Ridge Hill Road (both sides), Watsonia Road (both sides), Kalamunda Road (south side), Nangana Way (both sides), West Terrace (both sides), Simeon Close (both sides), Maud Road (both sides), Kent Road (both sides), Brewer Road (both sides), Bruce Road (both sides), East Sultana Road (both sides), West Sultana Road (both sides) and Milner Road (both sides) are included in the optional area. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (north side), Roe Highway (west side), Bushmead Road (north side) and Kalamunda Road (north side) are excluded from this optional area.

GOSNELLS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Ashburton Drive, Gosnells, Huntingdale and Wirrabirra, and the traditional catchment area of Seaforth Primary School.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the rail crossing of Fremantle Road and the railway line, south east along the railway line to the closest point west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east to the aforesaid junction and north east along Tonkin Highway to the Canning River, generally south along the Canning River to the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre, west along the aforesaid road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to the local government boundary between the City of Gosnells and the City of Armadale, north west and south west along this local government boundary to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay

Street to Warton Road, north east along Warton Road to Corfield Street, south east along Corfield Street to the Southern River, north, east and south east along the Canning River to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road and west along Fremantle Road to the railway crossing.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre (north side), Albany Highway (southern section, west side), Warton Road (south east side) and Corfield Street (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides), Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides), and Albany Highway (northern section, both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Ranford Road and Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street and its extension to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Barrett Street, south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Road, south west along Balfour Street to Ranford Road and south east along Ranford Road to Southern River Road. The boundary parts of Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides), Warton Road (south east side), Barrett Street (north east side), Balfour Street (south east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, south west along Tonkin Highway to the bridge over the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along the local government boundary to the western boundary of the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary site and continuing north to a point east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and in a generally westerly direction along Mills Road East to the junction with Tonkin Highway. The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), Canning Highway (east side), Pages Way (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Gosnells Senior High School and Yule Brook College—

From the eastern extremity of Rushton Road, west and north west along Rushton Road to Ellis Brook, in a generally westerly direction along Ellis Brook to Mills Road West, north west along Mills Road West to Gosnells Road, west along Gosnells Road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road, west along Fremantle Road to the railway line, south east and south along the railway line to a point due west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east from this point to Tonkin Highway, north east along Tonkin Highway to Mills Road East, east along Mills Road East to Pages Way and due east from this point. The boundary parts of Rushton Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Fremantle Road (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (west side) are included within this optional area, while the boundary parts of Mills Road West (both sides), Gosnells Road (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Canning Vale College, Gosnells Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Warton Road and Barrett Street, south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along Balfour Street to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Wright Road, south west along Wright Road to the main entrance of Carey College, north west from the main entrance of Carey College through Harrisdale Swamp to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Barrett Street. The boundary parts of Barrett Street (south west side), Balfour Street (north west side), Ranford Road (north east side) Wright Road (north west side) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area. (It is anticipated that this optional area will eventually become part of the local-intake area of a future secondary school in Southern River or Forrestdale, and will cease to be part of the local-intake area of Canning Vale College.)

GREENWOOD SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Warwick Road and the Mitchell Freeway, east along Warwick Road to Allenswood Road, north along Allenswood Road to Hepburn Avenue, east along Hepburn Avenue to Wanneroo Road, north along Wanneroo Road to a point due east of the east-west alignment of Montessori Place, west from this point to and along Montessori Place and its extension along the bike path to the Mitchell Freeway, and south along the Mitchell Freeway to Warwick Road. The boundary parts of Warwick Road (north side), Allenswood Road (west side), Hepburn Avenue (north side), Wanneroo Road (west side) and the Mitchell Freeway (east side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary street Montessori Place (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Greenwood Senior High School and Woodvale Senior High School—

From the intersection of Whitfords Avenue and the Mitchell Freeway, east along Whitfords Avenue to Wanneroo Road, south along Wanneroo Road to a point due east of the east-west

alignment of Montessori Place, west from this point to and along Montessori Place and its extension along the bike path to the Mitchell Freeway, and north along the Mitchell Freeway to Whitfords Avenue. The boundary parts of Whitfords Avenue (south side), Wanneroo Road (west side), Montessori Place (both sides) and the Mitchell Freeway (east side) are included within this optional area.

KALAMUNDA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Darlington, Edney, Falls Road, Glen Forrest, Gooseberry Hill, High Wycombe, Kalamunda and Maida Vale, the traditional catchment area of Walliston Primary School and the following exceptions.

Children from Falls Road Primary School living in the area north of Falls Road and the portion of Lesmurdie Road north of Falls Road are entitled to attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children from Falls Road Primary School living in the area south of Falls Road and south of the portion of Lesmurdie Road north of Falls Road are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School. Children living in Falls Road and the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road have the entitlement of attending either Kalamunda Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area north of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area south of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School. Children living in the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road and in Jackson Road have the entitlement of attending either Kalamunda Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestfield and Kalamunda Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass and the railway line, east along the Great Eastern Highway Bypass to the Roe Highway, north along the Roe Highway to Bushmead Road, east along Bushmead Road to the boundary between the Shires of Mundaring and Swan, south east along the shire boundary to Ridge Hill Road, south and south west along Ridge Hill Road to Watsonia Road, south, south east and south west along Watsonia Road to Kalamunda Road, south east along Kalamunda Road to Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way to the walk trail, west along the walk trail to West Terrace, north west and north along West Terrace to Simeon Close, west along Simeon Close and its extension to Maud Road, and continuing west along Maud Road to Hawtin Road, north along Hawtin Road to Kent Road, west along Kent Road to Brewer Road, south along Brewer Road to Bruce Road, west along Bruce Road to Sultana Road East, north west along Sultana Road East to Sultana Road West, continuing north west along Sultana Road West to Milner Road, south west along Milner Road to the boundary between the localities of Forrestfield and High Wycombe, west along this locality boundary to the local government boundary between the City of Belmont and the Shire of Kalamunda, north, north west and north east along the Shire of Kalamunda boundary to the railway line and north along the railway line to the Great Eastern Highway Bypass. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (south side), Roe Highway (east side), Bushmead Road (south side), Ridge Hill Road (both sides), Watsonia Road (both sides), Kalamunda Road (south side), Nangana Way (both sides), West Terrace (both sides), Simeon Close (both sides), Maud Road (both sides), Kent Road (both sides), Brewer Road (both sides), Bruce Road (both sides), East Sultana Road (both sides), West Sultana Road (both sides) and Milner Road (both sides) are included in the optional area. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (north side), Roe Highway (west side), Bushmead Road (north side) and Kalamunda Road (north side) are excluded from this optional area.

Children from Darlington Primary School are entitled to attend either Eastern Hills Senior High School, Kalamunda Senior High School or Swan View Senior High School

Children from Glen Forrest Primary School are entitled to attend either Eastern Hills Senior High School, Kalamunda Senior High School or Swan View Senior High School.

KELMSCOTT SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of Kingsley and Westfield Park Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools: Clifton Hills, Grovelands and Kelmscott.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Lake Road with Albany Highway, north along Albany Highway to the road that leads to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre, east along the aforesaid road to the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along this local government boundary to Canning Mills Road, south west along Canning Mills Road to a point due west of the southern extremity of Coventry Road, east from this point to a point due north of the eastern extremity of Buckingham Road, south from this point through the eastern extremity of Buckingham Road and continuing south through the junction of Brookton Highway and Stocker Road, and continuing south to a point due east of the eastern extension of Salter Road, west along this extension to Salter Road itself, and continuing west, and north along existing and proposed sections of Salter Road to Wahroonga Road, west along Wahroonga Road and its western

extension to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Galliers Avenue, west along Galliers Avenue and its extension to Railway Avenue, north along Railway Avenue to Champion Drive, north west along Champion Drive and its extension to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, north east and south east along this local government boundary to the intersection of Lake Road with Albany Highway.

The boundary parts of Albany Highway (northern section, east side), the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre (south side), Salter Road (both sides), Wahroonga Road (both sides), Albany Highway (southern section, west side), Galliers Avenue (both sides), Railway Avenue (both sides) and Champion Drive (north east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Canning Mills Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, south west along Tonkin Highway to the bridge over the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along the local government boundary to the western boundary of the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary site and continuing north to a point east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and in a generally westerly direction along Mills Road East to the junction with Tonkin Highway.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), Canning Highway (east side), Pages Way (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Kelmscott Senior High School and Roleystone District High School—

From the junction of Chevin Road and Canning Mills Road, east along Chevin Road to a point midway between Coventry Road and Hill Road, south from this point to a point due east of the southern extremity of Coventry Road, west from this point to Canning Mills Road and north east along Canning Mills Road to Chevin Road.

The boundary parts of Chevin Road (both sides) and Canning Mills Road (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Cecil Andrews and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of Lake Road and Champion Drive, south west along Lake Road to Bay Court, north west along Bay Court and its extension to the Southern River, north along the Southern River to the north westerly extension of Champion Drive, and south east along the extension of Champion Drive to Lake Road.

The boundary parts of Lake Road (west side), and Bay Court (both sides) are included within this optional area.

KENT STREET SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area of this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Cannington Community College, East Victoria Park and Kensington Primary Schools, and the traditional catchment areas of Bentley, Millen and Victoria Park Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Great Eastern Highway and the railway line, south and south east along the railway line to Welshpool Road, west along Welshpool Road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Leach Highway, south west along Leach Highway to Manning Road, west along Manning Road to a point due south of the southern extension of Hill View Terrace, north along this extension and Hill View Terrace to Walpole Street, north east along Walpole Street to Holder Street, west along Holder Street to Maquis Street, south west along Maquis Street to Hayman Road, generally north west along Hayman Road to Douglas Avenue, north west along Douglas Avenue and its north west extension to the Swan River foreshore, east and north along the Swan River foreshore to the Goongoonup Bridge, east and south along the railway line the Causeway to Great Eastern Highway. The boundary parts of Welshpool Road (north side), Albany Highway (south west side), Leach Highway (north west side), Manning Road (north side), Hill View Terrace and extension (east side), Walpole Street (south east side), Holder Street (north side), Maquis Street (north west side), Hayman Road (north east side), Douglas Avenue (north east side) and Great Eastern Highway (both sides) are included within the local-intake area for this school.

The following defines an optional area between Como Secondary College and Kent Street Senior High School—

From the junction of Douglas Avenue and South Terrace, north west along Douglas Avenue and its north westerly extension to the Swan River foreshore, north west and south along the Swan River foreshore to a point on the westerly extension of South Terrace, east along this extension and east along South Terrace to Douglas Avenue. The boundary parts of Douglas Avenue (south west side) and South Terrace (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Cannington Community College and Kent Street Senior High School—

From the intersection of Albany Highway and Leach Highway, north east along Leach Highway to the railway line, north west along the railway line to Welshpool Road, west along Welshpool Road to Albany Highway, and south east along Albany Highway to Leach Highway. The

boundary parts of Leach Highway (north west side), Welshpool Road (south side), and Albany Highway (north east side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Belmont City College and Kent Street Senior High School—

From the overpass of Victoria Park Drive and the Graham Farmer Freeway, south east along the Graham Farmer Freeway to Orrong Road, continuing south east along Orrong Road to Kewdale Road, south along Kewdale Road to Welshpool Road, west along Welshpool Road to the railway line, north west along the railway line to the Belmont Park railway station, and north east to the overpass of Victoria Park Drive and the Graham Farmer Freeway. The boundary parts of the Graham Farmer Freeway (south west side), Orrong Road (south west side), Kewdale Road (west side) and Welshpool Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

LEEMING SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools – Banksia Park, Bateman, Bull Creek, Leeming, Oberthur, West Leeming.

The following defines the local-intake area of Leeming Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Kwinana Freeway and South Street, west along South Street to Murdoch Drive, north along Murdoch Drive to Marsengo Road, east along Marsengo Road to the eastern part of Broadhurst Crescent, south along Broadhurst Crescent to Scandrett Way, east along Scandrett Way and its easterly extension to and across the Kwinana Freeway to the junction of Windich Road and Endeavour Avenue, continuing east along Windich Road and its easterly extension to Benningfield Road, south along Benningfield Road to Henry Bull Drive, east then south east along Henry Bull Drive to James Street, east along James Street to Hardy Street, southeast along Hardy Street to Darley Circle, south east along Darley Circle to More Crescent Crescent, north east along More Crescent to Back Close, east along Back Close and the walkway linking Back Close and Darley Circle, south along Darley Circle to Vagg Street, east along Vagg Street to Wheatley Drive, south along Wheatley Drive to South Street, east along South Street to the proposed Roe Highway, south west and west along the proposed Roe Highway to the Kwinana Freeway, north along the Kwinana Freeway to South Street.

The boundary parts of South Street (western section, north side), Murdoch Drive (east side), Marsengo Road (south side), Broadhurst Crescent (west side), Scandrett Way (northern arm, south side), Windich Road (both sides), Benningfield Road (both sides), Henry Bull Drive (both sides), James Street (both sides), Hardy Street (both sides), Darley Circle (both sides), More Crescent (both sides), Back Close (both sides), Vagg Street (both sides), South Street (eastern section, south side) and the Kwinana Freeway (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Wheatley Drive (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Leeming Senior High School and Rossmoyne Senior High School—

From the junction of Murdoch Drive and Hawke Pass, east along Hawke Pass to Parry Avenue, continuing east along Parry Avenue to the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to the northern arm of the loop forming Scandrett Way, west along the northern arm of Scandrett Way to Broadhurst Crescent, north along Broadhurst Crescent to Marsengo Road, west along Marsengo Road to Murdoch Drive and north along Murdoch Drive to Parry Avenue. The boundary parts of Hawke Pass (south side), Parry Avenue (south side), Kwinana Freeway (west side), northern arm of Scandrett Way (north side), Broadhurst Crescent (east side), Marsengo Road (north side) and Murdoch Drive (east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Leeming Senior High School and Willetton Senior High School—

From the junction of South Street and Wheatley Drive, north along Wheatley Drive to the southern arm of Oberthur Crescent, east between Oberthur Crescent and Weeks Way to the walkway linking Weeks Way and Anstie Way, east along this walkway to Anstie Way, north then east along the northern part of Anstie Way to Hetherington Drive, north-east along Hetherington Drive to Owgan Place, south-east along Owgan Place to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to South Street and west along South Street to Wheatley Drive. The boundary parts of Wheatley Drive, Anstie Way, Owgan Place (both sides in all cases), Karel Avenue (west side) and South Street (north side) are included within this optional area, whilst the boundary parts of Hetherington Drive (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Leeming Senior High School and Willetton Senior High School—

From the intersection of Parry Avenue and the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to a point opposite the western extension of Windich Road, in an easterly direction to and along Windich Road and its eastward extension to Benningfield Road, south along Benningfield Road to Henry Bull Drive, east then south-east along Henry Bull Drive to James Street, east along James Street to Hardy Street, south-east along Hardy Street to Darley Circle, south-east along Darley Circle to More Crescent, north-east along More Crescent to Back Close, east along Back Close and the walkway linking Back Close and Darley Circle, south along Darley Circle to Vagg Street, east along Vagg Street to Wheatley Drive, north along Wheatley Drive to Parry Avenue and west along Parry Avenue to the Kwinana Freeway. The boundary parts of Parry Avenue (south side), Wheatley Drive (both sides) and the Kwinana Freeway (east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts (both sides) of all other streets are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Leeming Senior High School and Lakeland Senior High School—

From the junction of Farrington Road and the Kwinana Freeway, west along Farrington Road to Bibra Drive, south along Bibra Drive to the proposed Roe Highway, east along the proposed Roe Highway to the Kwinana Freeway and north along the Kwinana Freeway to Farrington Road. The boundary parts of the Kwinana Freeway (west side), Farrington Road (south side), Bibra Drive (east side) and the proposed Roe Highway (north side) are included within this optional area.

LESMURDIE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of Falls Road and Lesmurdie Primary Schools, the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools : Pickering Brook, Walliston and Wattle Grove; and the following exceptions.

Children from Falls Road Primary School living in the area south of Falls Road and south of the portion of Lesmurdie Road north of Falls Road are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School. Children from Falls Road Primary School living in the area north of Falls Road and the portion of Lesmurdie Road north of Falls Road are entitled to attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children living in Falls Road and the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road are entitled to attend either Lesmurdie Senior High School or Kalamunda Senior High School.

Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area south of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School. Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area north of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled to attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children living in the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road and in Jackson Road are entitled to attend either Lesmurdie Senior High School or Kalamunda Senior High School.

Children from Wattle Grove Primary School are entitled to attend either Lesmurdie Senior High School or Forrestfield Senior High School.

LYNWOOD SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Brookman, Ferndale, Kinlock, Langford, Lynwood and Parkwood.

MANDURAH HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Greenfields, Mandurah, North Mandurah, Riverside and Singleton.

The following defines the local-intake area of Mandurah High School—

From the entry of the Mandurah Estuary into the Indian Ocean, south along the Mandurah Estuary to the 'old' Mandurah Bridge, east along Pinjarra Road to the intersection with Fremantle Road, north along Fremantle Road to Gordon Road, east along Gordon Road to Lakes Road, north and east along Lakes Road to the Serpentine River, north along the Serpentine River to the boundary between the Shires of Murray and Rockingham, west along the Murray-Rockingham and Mandurah-Rockingham Shire boundaries to Fremantle Road, south along Fremantle Road to a point on the easterly extension of the proposed George Hibbert Road, west from this point on Fremantle Road along the easterly extension of George Hibbert Road, west along George Hibbert Road, and west along its westerly extension to the coastline, south along the coastline to the entry of the Mandurah Estuary into the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of Pinjarra Road (north side), Fremantle Road (southern section, west side), Gordon Road (north side), Lakes Road (north side), the Murray-Rockingham and Mandurah-Rockingham Shire boundaries (south side), Fremantle Road (northern section, east side) and George Hibbert Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of Mandurah High School.

The following defines an optional area between Coodanup Community College and Mandurah High School—

From the intersection of Fremantle Road and Murdoch Drive east along Murdoch Drive to Bortolo Drive, north along Bortolo Drive to Exchequer Avenue, east along Exchequer Avenue to Lakes Road, north along Lakes Road to Gordon Road, west along Gordon Road to Fremantle Road and south along Fremantle Road to Murdoch Drive. The boundary parts of Murdoch Drive (north side), Bortolo Drive (west side), Exchequer Avenue (north side), Lakes Road (west side), Gordon Road (south side) and Fremantle Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Comet Bay College and Mandurah High School—

From the coastline of the Indian Ocean, east along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to Fremantle Road, south along Fremantle Road to a point on the easterly extension of the proposed George Hibbert Road, west from this point on Fremantle Road along the easterly extension of George Hibbert Road, west along George Hibbert Road, and west along its westerly extension to the coastline, north along the coastline to the locality boundary of Madora Bay and Singleton. The boundary parts of Fremantle Road (west side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of George Hibbert Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

ROSSMOYNE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Bateman, Brentwood, Bull Creek, Oberthur, Riverton, Shelley and Willetton, and the traditional catchment area of Rossmoyne Primary School.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Murdoch Drive, east along Leach Highway to the junction with Bull Creek Drive, north from this junction through Bateman Park to the foreshore of Bull Creek, east and north along the eastern foreshore of Bull Creek, and continuing north east and east along the foreshore of the Canning River to the northern extension of Duff Road, south along this extension and Duff Road to High Road, west along High Road to Augusta Street, south along Augusta Street to Acanthus Road, west along Acanthus Road to Darvell Road, south along Darvell Road to Rhonda Avenue, west along Rhonda Avenue to the northern extension of Donald Street, south along this extension and Donald Street to Apsley Road, west along Apsley Road to Eagles Walk, south along the north-south alignment of Eagles Walk and its extension to Flamingo Way, south along the north-south alignment of Flamingo Way and its extension to Albatross Pass, west along Albatross Pass and its extension between Wren Close and Cormorant Cross, and continuing north east between Brolga Promenade and both The Taffrail and The Quarterdeck to the junction of The Quarterdeck and The Escarpment, west from this junction to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to Parry Avenue, west along Parry Avenue to Murdoch Drive, and north along Murdoch Drive to Leach Highway.

The boundary parts of Leach Highway (south side), Duff Road (both sides), High Road (north side), Augusta Street (both sides), Acanthus Road (both sides), Darvell Road (both sides), Donald Street (both sides), Eagles Walk (both sides), Flamingo Way (both sides), Wren Close (both sides), Brolga Promenade (both sides), Karel Avenue (west side), Parry Avenue (north side) and Murdoch Drive (east side) are included in the above local-intake area. Albatross Pass (both sides), Cormorant Cross (both sides), The Taffrail (both sides) and The Quarterdeck (both sides) are excluded from this area.

Students resident within the following area have the entitlement of attending either Rossmoyne Senior High School or Leeming Senior High School—

From the junction of Murdoch Drive and Parry Avenue, east along Parry Avenue to the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to the northern arm of the loop forming Scandrett Way, west along the northern arm of Scandrett Way to Broadhurst Crescent, north along Broadhurst Crescent to Marsengo Road, west along Marsengo Road to Murdoch Drive and north along Murdoch Drive to Parry Avenue. The boundary parts of Parry Avenue (south side), Kwinana Freeway (west side), northern arm of Scandrett Way (north side), Broadhurst Crescent (east side), Marsengo Road (north side) and Murdoch (east side) are included within this optional area.

Students resident within the following area have the entitlement of attending either Applecross Senior High School or Rossmoyne Senior High School—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Riseley Street, north along Riseley Street to Karoonda Road, east along Karoonda Road to Canning Avenue, north east along Canning Avenue and its extension to the Canning River foreshore, south along the Canning River and Bull Creek foreshores to Bateman Park, south through Bateman Park to the junction of Leach Highway and Bull Creek Drive, west along Leach Highway to the junction with Riseley Street.

The boundary parts of Riseley Street (east side) and Leach Highway (north side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Karoonda Road (both sides) and Canning Avenue (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

Secondary students who reside south of High Road in the local-intake area of Riverton Primary School, and who were enrolled at Riverton Primary School for the whole of the year whilst in Year 7 at that school, are entitled to attend Rossmoyne Senior High School.

THORNLIE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and the railway line, north east along the railway line to Albany Highway, south east along Albany Highway to Austin Avenue, south west along the locality boundary between Kenwick and Maddington to the Canning River, generally south along the Canning River to the confluence of the Canning River and the Southern River, south along the Southern River to Corfield Street, north east along Corfield Street to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Garden Street, north west along Garden Street to Nicholson Road, and north along Nicholson Road to the railway line. The boundary parts of Albany Highway (south west side), Corfield Street (north side), Warton Road (north west side) and Garden Street (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Lynwood Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Canning River and the railway line, south west along the railway line to Cameron Street, north west along Cameron Street to the Roe Highway, north east along the proposed Roe Highway to the Canning River, and generally south east along the Canning River to the railway line. The boundary parts of Cameron Street (north east side) and the Roe Highway (south east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Ranford Road and Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street and its extension to Warton Road, south west

along Warton Road to Barrett Street, south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Road, south west along Balfour Street to Ranford Road and south east along Ranford Road to Southern River Road. The boundary parts of Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides), Warton Road (south east side), Barrett Street (north east side), Balfour Street (south east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Canning Vale College, Gosnells Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Warton Road and Barrett Street, south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along Balfour Street to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Wright Road, south west along Wright Road to the main entrance of Carey College, north west from the main entrance of Carey College through Harrisdale Swamp to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Barrett Street. The boundary parts of Barrett Street (south west side), Balfour Street (north west side), Ranford Road (north east side) Wright Road (north west side) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area. (It is anticipated that this optional area will eventually become part of the local-intake area of a future secondary school in Southern River or Forrestdale, and will cease to be part of the local-intake area of Canning Vale College.)

WESTERN SUBURBS SECONDARY SCHOOL CLUSTER

The two schools in the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster are: Churchlands Senior High School (SHS) and Perth Modern School. Students resident within the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster are entitled to attend either of the secondary schools in the Cluster.

The following defines the local-intake area of the Cluster—

From a point on the Indian Ocean coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and Rochdale Road, east from the coastline to this junction, north along West Coast Highway to Oceanic Drive, east along Oceanic Drive and its extension into Cambridge Street, east along Cambridge Street to Station Street (northern section), south along Station Street (northern section) to Salvado Road, east along Salvado Road to Station Street (southern section), south along Station Street (southern section) to the railway line, south east from the railway line to the junction of Roberts Road and Rokeby Road, south along Rokeby Road to Nicholson Road, east along Nicholson Road to Thomas Street, south east through Kings Park to the Old Brewery on the Swan River, in a generally east and north east direction along the Swan River to Summers Street (East Perth), west along Summers Street (eastern section) to the railway line, west across the railway line to Summers Street (western section), west along Summers Street to Bulwer Street, north west along Bulwer Street to Vincent Street, west along Vincent Street to Charles Street, north along Charles Street to Green Street, west along Green Street to Scarborough Beach Road, west, north west and west along Scarborough Beach Road and its western extension to the coastline, and south along the coastline to a point due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and Rochdale Road.

The boundary parts of West Coast Highway (west side), Oceanic Drive (north side), Cambridge Street (north side), Station Street (northern and southern sections, east side), Salvado Road (north side), Rokeby Road (east side), Nicholson Road (north side), Summers Street (both sections, both sides), Bulwer Street (both sides), Charles Street (both sides), Green Street (south side) and Scarborough Beach Road (south side) are included within the local-intake area of the Cluster. The boundary parts of Vincent Street (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster and Carine Senior High School—

From a point on the Indian Ocean coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive, east from this point to the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive, north east along West Coast Highway to Karrinyup Road, east and south east along Karrinyup Road to Huntriss Road, south along Huntriss Road to Barnes Street, west along Barnes Street to Holbeck Street, south along Holbeck Street to Scarborough Beach Road, north west and west along Scarborough Beach Road and its western extension to the coastline and north along the coastline to a point on the coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and West Coast Drive. The boundary parts of West Coast Highway (south side), Karrinyup Road (south side), Huntriss Road (both sides), Barnes Street (both sides), Holbeck Street (both sides) and Scarborough Beach Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster and Balcatta Senior High School—

From the intersection of Sackville Terrace and Holbeck Street, east along Sackville Terrace and Barnes Street to Odin Road, north along Odin Road to the southern arm of Birrale Loop, east between the southern arm of Birrale Loop and Hertha Place to the Mitchell Freeway, south and south east along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road, north west along Scarborough Beach Road to Holbeck Street and north along Holbeck Street to Sackville Terrace. The boundary parts of the Sackville Terrace (south side), Barnes Road (south side), Odin Road (east side), Hertha Place (both sides), Mitchell Freeway (west side) and Scarborough Beach Road (north side) are included with this optional area. The boundary parts of Birrale Loop (both sides) and Holbeck Street (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster and Mirrabooka Senior High School—

From the junction of the Mitchell Freeway and Scarborough Beach Road, east along Scarborough Beach Road to Green Street, east along Green Street to Wanneroo Road, north along Wanneroo

Road to Roberts Street, west along Roberts Street to the Mitchell Freeway and south along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road. The boundary parts of Scarborough Beach Road (north side), Green Street (north side) Wanneroo Road (west side) and the Mitchell Freeway (east side) are included within this option area. Roberts Street (both sides) is excluded from this option area.

WARNBRO COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this secondary school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools : Charthouse, Koorana, Port Kennedy, Rockingham Lakes, Secret Harbour, Waikiki and Warnbro.

The following defines the local-intake area for Warnbro Community High School—

From the junction of Safety Bay Road and Hilda Road, south west and west along Hilda Road to the Indian Ocean coastline, south along the coastline to a point due west of the most north westerly point of Antonio Circuit, east from this point on the coastline to the north west corner of Antonio Circuit, east between Antonio Circuit and Knutsford Crescent, then east keeping the following streets in brackets all on the north (Tryall Avenue, Belmont Close, Trafalgar Gardens, Nunton Place, Rueval Court and Benbecula Loop) and keeping the following streets in brackets all on the south (Majestic Close, Bounty Court, Bingarra Close, Nautilus Close, Ceri Close, Galley Close and Batavia Court), and continuing east to Warnbro Sound Avenue, south along Warnbro Sound Avenue to Port Kennedy Drive, east along Port Kennedy Drive to Ennis Avenue, north along Ennis Avenue to Willmott Drive, north west along Willmott Drive to Gngangara Drive, west along Gngangara Drive to Read Street, south along Read Street to Rand Avenue, west along Rand Avenue to Safety Bay Road, and south east along Safety Bay Road to Hilda Road.

The boundary parts of Hilda Road (both sides), Warnbro Sound Avenue (east side), Port Kennedy Drive (north side), Ennis Avenue (west side), Willmott Drive (south west side), Gngangara Drive (south side), Read Street (east side), Rand Avenue (south side), Safety Bay Road (north east side) and Hilda Road (south side) are included within the catchment area for Warnbro Community High School

WILLETTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Bull Creek, Burrendah, Oberthur, Riverton, Rostrata and Willetton.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of High Road and Augusta Street, south along Augusta Street to Acanthus Road, west along Acanthus Road to Darvell Road, south along Darvell Road to Rhonda Avenue, west along Rhonda Avenue to the northern extension of Donald Street, south along this extension and Donald Street to Apsley Road, west along Apsley Road to Eagles Walk, south along the north-south alignment of Eagles Walk and its extension to Flamingo Way, south along the north-south alignment of Flamingo Way and its extension to Albatross Pass, west along Albatross Pass and its extension between Wren Close and Cormorant Cross, and continuing north east between Brolga Promenade and both The Taffrail and The Quarterdeck to the junction of The Quarterdeck and The Escarpment, west from this junction to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to Parry Avenue, west along Parry Avenue to Wheatley Drive, south along Wheatley Drive to the southern arm of Oberthur Crescent, east between Oberthur Crescent and Weeks Way to the walkway linking Weeks Way and Anstie Way, east along this walkway to Anstie Way, north then east along the northern part of Anstie Way to Hetherington Drive, north-east along Hetherington Drive to Owgan Place, south-east along Owgan Place to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to South Street, east along South Street to the proposed Roe Highway, north east along the proposed Roe Highway to Willeri Drive, north along Willeri Drive to High Road and west along High Road to Augusta Street.

The boundary parts of Albatross Pass (both sides), Cormorant Cross (both sides), The Taffrail (both sides), The Quarterdeck (both sides), Karel Avenue (east side for both northern and southern sections), Parry Avenue (south side), Wheatley Drive (between Vagg Street and Oberthur Crescent, both sides), Oberthur Crescent (both sides), Hetherington Drive (both sides), South Street (north side), Willeri Drive (west side) and High Road (south side) are included in this local-intake area. The boundary parts of Augusta Street (both sides), Acanthus Road (western section, both sides), Darvell Road (both sides), Donald Street (both sides), Eagles Walk (both sides), Flamingo Way (both sides), Wren Close (both sides), Brolga Promenade (both sides) and Wheatley Drive (between Parry Avenue and Vagg Street, both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Leeming Senior High School and Willetton Senior High School—

From the junction of South Street and Wheatley Drive, north along Wheatley Drive to the southern arm of Oberthur Crescent, east between Oberthur Crescent and Weeks Way to the walkway linking Weeks Way and Anstie Way, east along this walkway to Anstie Way, north then east along the northern part of Anstie Way to Hetherington Drive, north-east along Hetherington Drive to Owgan Place, south-east along Owgan Place to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to South Street and west along South Street to Wheatley Drive. The boundary parts of Wheatley Drive, Anstie Way, Owgan Place (both sides in all cases), Karel Avenue (west side) and South Street (north side) are included within this optional area, whilst the boundary parts of Hetherington Drive (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Willetton Senior High School and Leeming Senior High School—

From the intersection of Parry Avenue and the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to a point opposite the western extension of Windich Road, in an easterly direction to

and along Windich Road and its eastward extension to Benningfield Road, south along Benningfield Road to Henry Bull Drive, east then south-east along Henry Bull Drive to James Street, east along James Street to Hardy Street, south-east along Hardy Street to Darley Circle, south-east along Darley Circle to More Crescent, north-east along More Crescent to Back Close, east along Back Close and the walkway linking Back Close and Darley Circle, south along Darley Circle to Vagg Street, east along Vagg Street to Wheatley Drive, north along Wheatley Drive to Parry Avenue and west along Parry Avenue to the Kwinana Freeway. The boundary parts of Parry Avenue (south side), Wheatley Drive (both sides) and the Kwinana Freeway (east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts (both sides) of all other streets are excluded from this optional area.

WOODVALE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Ocean Reef Road, west along Ocean Reef Road to the Mitchell Freeway, south along the Mitchell Freeway to Whitfords Avenue, east along Whitfords Avenue to Wanneroo Road, and north along Wanneroo Road to Ocean Reef Road. The boundary parts of Ocean Reef Road (south side), Mitchell Freeway (east side), Whitfords Avenue (north side), and Wanneroo Road (west side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Woodvale Senior High School and Greenwood Senior High School—

From the intersection of Whitfords Avenue and the Mitchell Freeway, east along Whitfords Avenue to Wanneroo Road, south along Wanneroo Road to a point due east of the east-west alignment of Montessori Place, west from this point to and along Montessori Place and its extension along the bike path to the Mitchell Freeway, and north along the Mitchell Freeway to Whitfords Avenue. The boundary parts of Whitfords Avenue (south side), Wanneroo Road (west side), Montessori Place (both sides) and the Mitchell Freeway (east side) are included within this optional area.

ED404**UNIVERSITY OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA ACT 1911**

THE UNIVERSITY OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA LANDS BY-LAWS

The University of Western Australia, in pursuance of the University of Western Australia Act 1911, hereby makes the following amendments to The University of Western Australia Lands By-laws, for the purpose of regulating the terms and conditions under which those lands may be visited or used and the conduct of persons when on those lands—

FIRST SCHEDULE

PART 2 is amended by adding the following—

CLAREMONT CAMPUS

41. Lot 14456 on Deposited Plan 30905 and being the whole of the land in Record of Certificate of Crown Land title Volume LR3127 Folio 395.

HEALTH**HE401*****HEALTH SERVICES (QUALITY IMPROVEMENT) ACT 1994**

STANDARDS

Established by the Minister for Health for the purposes of Section 9(1)(B) of the Health Services (Quality Improvement) Act 1994

BACKGROUND

The aim of any quality improvement committee is to improve the quality of health care delivered to patients. Quality improvement committees registered under the *Health Services (Quality Improvement) Act 1994* (the Act) are required to fulfil a number of functions as outlined in section 7 (2)(c) of the Act. These activities include—

- the assessment and evaluation of the quality of health services, including the review of clinical practices;
- the reporting and making of recommendations to its governing body concerning health services; and,
- the monitoring of the implementation of those recommendations.

PURPOSE

These Standards are established by the Minister for Health for the purposes of section 9(1)(b) of the Act. The purpose of these Standards is to enable a person who acquires any information solely as a result of the performance of the Committee's functions to make a record of, divulge and communicate

that information for the making available to the public or a section of the public of information that does not, either expressly or by implication, disclose the identity of an individual or individuals.

These Standards are in addition to the restrictions imposed by section 8(2) of the Act.

DEFINITIONS

In these Standards—

“**Act**” means the *Health Services (Quality Improvement) Act 1994*;

“**Committee**” means a committee that is declared, or is by section 14 of the Act taken to have been declared, to be an approved quality improvement committee under section 7(1) of the Act;

“**Department of Health**” means the department principally assisting the Minister for Health in the administration of the Act and responsible for the State-wide administration of health services;

“**family connection**” means a connection identifying an individual by reference to members of their family. For example, by reference to a spouse/de-facto-partner/sister/grand-daughter of the person;

“**governing body**” means the person or body (by whatever name called) having the general direction and control of, and overall responsibility for, the operations of—

- (a) a health service; or
- (b) an association, society, college, faculty or other body of professionals who provide a health care service;

“**health professional**” means a person practising a particular discipline or profession in the health area and includes a medical practitioner, nurse, midwife, occupational therapist, osteopath, chiropractor, optometrist, pharmacist, physiotherapist, podiatrist, radiographer, psychologist;

“**health section of the public**” means that section of the public comprising—

- (a) employees of the Department of Health;
- (b) employees of a health service;
- (c) health professionals;
- (d) members of an association, society, college, faculty or other body of professionals who provide health services; and
- (e) employees of other Australian and international government agencies responsible for the provision and administration of health services and health legislation.

“**health service**” means—

- (a) any medical, hospital, ambulance, paramedical, dental, pharmaceutical, mental health, nursing home, palliative care, community health or environmental health service;
- (b) any service relating to or associated with the provision of a service referred to in paragraph (a); or
- (c) any other service relating to or associated with the maintenance or improvement of the health, or the restoration to health, of persons or the prevention of disease in or injury to persons;

“**identifying feature**” means any semi permanent or permanent physical identifying feature (eg. scar, excessive body mass index, skin colour);

“**information**” includes reports;

“**public**” means open to all persons;

“**Regulations**” means the Health Services (Quality Improvement) Regulations 1995; and

“**sentinel event information**” means information about the following events—

- Procedures involving the wrong patient or body part;
- Suicide of a patient in an inpatient unit;
- Retained instruments or other material after surgery requiring re-operation or further surgical procedure;
- Intravascular gas embolism resulting in death or neurological damage;
- Haemolytic blood transfusion reaction resulting from ABO incompatibility;
- Medication error leading to the death of a patient reasonably believed to be due to incorrect administration of drugs;
- Maternal death or serious morbidity associated with labour or delivery;
- Infant discharged to wrong family or infant abduction; and
- Any other catastrophic event resulting in serious patient harm or patient death.

STANDARD 1: Reports made by a Committee to the Minister for Health and the public in accordance with the Regulations

1.1 In accordance with regulation 9 of the Regulations, a Committee is to make available to the public at least once in each period of 12 months, by such means as is determined by the governing body which established the Committee, a report containing the following information—

- (a) the services which have been assessed and evaluated by the Committee during that period;

- (b) any action taken (described in general terms) as a result of the assessment and evaluation referred to in paragraph (a); and
- (c) if known at the time of preparation of the report, any results of the action referred to in paragraph (b).

1.2 In accordance with regulation 10 of the Regulations, a Committee is to furnish the Minister for Health at least once annually and more often if so directed by the Minister, a report containing the following information—

- (a) details of the reports made available to the public under regulation 9 during the relevant period and the manner in which the reports were made available;
- (b) a statement indicating whether or not the exercise of the functions of the Committee has been and will continue to be facilitated by the provision of the immunities and protections afforded by the Act; and
- (c) a statement indicating whether or not it has been and will continue to be in the public interest to restrict disclosure of information compiled by the Committee in the course of the performance of the Committee's functions.

1.3 The reports provided under regulations 9 and 10 of the Regulations shall not disclose in relation to an individual or individuals the following information: names, address, dates of birth, age, family connection, occupation, qualifications, membership of a professional body, home or workplace location or region, religious denomination, cultural background, ethnicity, nationality, gender, gender history, sexual orientation, sexual orientation history, marital status or an identifying feature.

STANDARD 2: Release of information by a Committee or the governing body to the health section of the public

2.1 Information which may be made available by a Committee or the governing body to the health section of the public may include information on—

- the assessment and evaluation of the quality of health services, including the review of clinical practices;
- the reporting and making of recommendations concerning health services; and,
- the monitoring of the implementation of those recommendations.

2.2 In particular, this standard applies to the provision of sentinel event information to the Department of Health as outlined in Operational Circular OP 1679/03 and the statewide sentinel event policy.

2.3 The information provided to the health section of the public shall not disclose in relation to an individual or individuals the following information: names, addresses, dates of birth, home or workplace location, religious denomination, nationality or marital status.

2.4 The age of the recipient of the health service should only be disclosed where it is relevant to the health condition of the recipient. If the age of the recipient of the health service is over 95 years of age, then that person should be referred to as a person in the centenarian age group.

2.5 The family connection of the recipient of the health service should only be disclosed if the medical history or family history of the recipient of the health service is relevant to the assessment, diagnosis and treatment of an individual's medical condition (eg. maternal history of diabetes, family history of genetic disorders).

2.6 The occupation, qualifications, membership of a professional body, cultural background, race or ethnicity of the recipient of the health service should only be disclosed where it is relevant to the health condition of the recipient of the health service or relevant to an understanding of the health services being assessed and evaluated (eg. requirement for interpreting services).

2.7 The gender, gender history, sexual orientation, sexual orientation history or an identifying feature of the recipient of the health service should only be disclosed where it is relevant to the health condition of the recipient of the health service or where it would be inferred from the particular health condition or procedure undertaken (eg. pregnancy, prostate cancer, gender reassignment).

2.8 The occupation, qualifications and membership of professional bodies of the provider(s) of the health service should only be disclosed by identifying them as being a health professional (eg. medical practitioner, nurse) or as a member of a specialty grouping (ie. surgeon, anaesthetist, psychiatrist, obstetrician, midwife, community nurse, paramedic) and then such disclosure should only be made where it is relevant to an understanding of the health services being assessed and evaluated (eg. the performance of particular operation by a surgeon) or to identifying a class of health professionals to whom recommendations should be directed (eg. medical practitioners, nurses).

2.9 The cultural background, race, ethnicity, gender, gender history, sexual orientation or sexual orientation history of the provider(s) of the health service should only be disclosed where it is relevant to an understanding of the health services being assessed and evaluated or to identifying a class of health professionals to whom recommendations should be directed (eg. male or female medical practitioners, male or female nurses).

2.10 A region of Western Australia may only be described by use of the terms 'metropolitan' or 'rural'.

STANDARD 3: Sharing of information within the health section of the public

3.1 Where persons within the health section of the public have been provided with information under Standard 2, they may further share that information in the form of safety alerts, newsletters, bulletins, reports, data and the like with other persons within the health section of the public for the purpose of improving the quality of health services.

STANDARD 4: Release of information by the health section of the public to the public

4.1 Subject to the restrictions in Standard 4.2, the health section of the public may release information provided under Standard 2 to the public.

4.2 This information shall not disclose in relation to an individual or individuals the following information: names, address, dates of birth, age, family connection, occupation, qualifications, membership of a professional body, home or workplace location or region, religious denomination, cultural background, ethnicity, nationality, gender, gender history, sexual orientation, sexual orientation history, marital status or an identifying feature.
