Fish Resources Management Act 1994

Fish Resources Management Amendment Regulations 2002

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Fish Resources Management Amendment Regulations 2002*.

2. Regulation 38H replaced

Regulation 38H of the *Fish Resources Management Regulations 1995** is repealed and the following regulation is inserted instead —

“

38H. Use of certain nets or snare to fish for marron

Subject to regulation 38I and Division 7B, a person must not fish for marron by using anything except —

- (a) not more than 6 marron drop nets;
- (b) a single marron pole snare; or
- (c) a single marron scoop net.

Penalty: For a first offence \$5 000 or, for a second or subsequent offence, \$10 000 and, for any offence, the penalty provided in section 222 of the Act.

”.

RULES OF HARNESS RACING 1999

Notice of Amendment

Notice is hereby given that the Committee of the Western Australian Trotting Association at Gloucester Park, East Perth, on the 10 January 2002 resolved by majority of members of the Committee that the Rules of Harness Racing 1999 be amended as follows—

1. Local Rule 14 is deleted and the following new local rule substituted—

LR 14. Appointment of Stewards

- (1) Rule 14(1) shall not apply.

Footnote:

The power of the Committee to appoint stewards is conferred by the Bylaws.

- (2) Notwithstanding rule 14(2), the Committee may appoint 2 Deputy Chairmen of Stewards, and may, from time to time, designate which of them is to be the Chief Steward at any meeting or race at which the Chairman is not in official attendance.
 - (3) Rule 14(4) shall not apply.
 - (4) For the purpose of rule 14(7), the reference to “Deputy Chairman” shall be taken to be reference to “Deputy Chairmen”.
