### **LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995**

*City of Stirling*

#### **LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROPERTY AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2011**

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Stirling resolved on 13 September 2011 to make the following local law.

**1. Citation**

This local law may be cited as the *City of Stirling Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2011*.

**2. Commencement**

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.

**3. Principal local law**

In this local law the *City of Stirling Local Government Property Local Law 2009* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 5 June 2009, is referred to as the principal local law. The principal local law is amended.

**4. Contents amended**

In Contents delete “4.8 Signs” and insert “4.8 Umbrellas and temporary shade structures” and “4.9 Signs”.

**5. Clause 1.5 amended**

In clause 1.5 delete the definition *glass container*.

**6. Clause 3.14 amended**

Delete subclause (3) and insert—

- “(3) Except in accordance with a permit, a person must not—
- (a) camp on, or lodge at, local government property;
  - (b) occupy any structure at night for the purpose of sleeping on local government property;
  - (c) park a vehicle on local government property where that vehicle is being used, by that person or any other person, for purposes of camping or sleeping on local government property; or
  - (d) erect a tent, camp, hut or similar structure on local government property.”

**7. Clause 4.8 deleted**

Delete clause 4.8 and its heading.

**8. Clause 4.9 amended**

Clause 4.9 titled “Umbrellas and temporary shade structures” is renumbered to 4.8 and—

- (a) in subclause (d) insert “and” after “;”;
- (b) in subclause (e) delete “;and” and insert “.”; and
- (c) delete subclause (f).

**9. Schedule 1 amended**

In Schedule 1—

- (a) delete reference to clause 4.8;
- (b) renumber 4.9 to 4.8; and
- (c) renumber 4.10(2) to 4.9(2).

### ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY ACT 2004

#### 3. The Electricity Networks Access Code amended

These amendments are to the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004*\* (“Code”).

#### 4. Insert new price control objective regarding deferred revenue

Insert new section 6.4(a)(iiA) as follows—

“ (iiA) an amount (if any) determined under sections 6.5A to 6.5E;  
plus: ”.

#### 5. Insert a new heading and new sections after section 6.5

##### “ Recovery of deferred revenue

6.5A In this Chapter, “deferred revenue” means the amounts referred to in paragraphs 5.37A and 5.48A of the Amended Proposed Revisions dated 24 December 2009 to the Western Power Network access arrangement, as approved by the Authority’s further final decision dated 19 January 2010, expressed in present value terms as at 30 June 2009 and in real dollar values as at 30 June 2009, being respectively—

- (a) \$64.5 million; and
- (b) \$484.2 million.

6.5B An amount in respect of deferred revenue must be added to the target revenue for the Western Power Network for one or more access arrangement periods until the aggregate amount referred to in section 6.5E has been added.

6.5C An amount added to the target revenue under section 6.5B must include an adjustment so that the deferral of the deferred revenue is financially neutral for the Electricity Networks Corporation, taking into account—

- (a) the time value of money; and
- (b) inflation.

6.5D The Authority must determine the amount to be added under section 6.5B in a given access arrangement period.

6.5E The total of all amounts added under section 6.5B (aggregated over all access arrangement periods for which such amounts are added) must equal—

- (a) the total amount of the deferred revenue;  
plus:
- (b) the sum of all adjustments under section 6.5C. ”.

FIRE BREAK NOTICE

Notice to All Owners and/or Occupiers of Land in the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 (1) (a) (b) of the *Bush Fires Act 1954*, you are hereby required on or before the 1st day of November 2011 or within fourteen days of your becoming owner or occupier of land should this be after the 1st day of November 2011 to clear firebreaks and remove flammable material from the land owned or occupied by you as specified hereunder and to have the specified land and firebreaks clear of all flammable material from the 1st day of November 2011 up to and including the 14th day of April 2012.

Land Outside Townsite—

- (a) All buildings on land which are outside townsite shall be surrounded by two firebreaks not less than two metres wide cleared of all flammable material, the inner firebreak to be not more than twenty metres from the perimeter of the building or group of buildings and the outer firebreak not less than 200 metres from the inner firebreak.

To remove flammable material from the whole of the land between the firebreaks required in paragraph (a) above.

Land in Townsite—

- (b) Where the area of land is **2,000 square metres or less**, all flammable material shall be removed from the whole of the land.

Where the area of land **exceeds 2,000 square metres**, firebreaks at least 3 metres in width shall be cleared of all flammable material immediately inside and along the boundaries of the land. Where there are buildings on the land, additional firebreaks shall be cleared immediately surrounding each building.

If it is considered for any reason to be impractical to clear firebreaks or remove flammable material required by this notice, you may apply to the Council or its duly appointed Officer not later than the 15th November 2011 for permission to provide firebreaks in alternative positions or take alternative action to remove or abate fire hazards. If permission is not granted by Council or its duly authorised Officer, you shall comply with the requirements of this notice.

“Flammable material” does not include green growing trees or green growing plants in gardens.

If the requirements of this notice are carried out by burning, such burning shall comply with the relevant provisions of the *Bush Fire Act 1954*.

In accordance with Section 33 (3) of the *Bush Fire Act 1954*, failing to comply with this notice may result in a maximum penalty of \$5,000. A person in default is also liable, whether prosecuted or not, to pay cost of performing the work directed in this notice, if it is not carried out by the owner or occupier by the date required by this notice.

The prohibited burning periods will be—

1. Within the gazetted Kalgoorlie-Boulder Fire District from 15th December 2011 to 14th April 2012 inclusive;
2. Outside the Kalgoorlie-Boulder Fire District from 1st November 2011 to 30th April 2012.

#### FIRE BREAK NOTICE

Notice to All Owners and/or Occupiers of Land situated in the City of Melville

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the above Act, you are hereby required on or before the 15th day of November 2011 or within 14 days of the date of you becoming the owner or occupier, should this be after the 15th day of November 2011 and thereafter up to and including the 30th day of April 2012 to clear flammable matter from that land in accordance with the following requirements—

- A As to land which is 1,500 square metres or less in area, or which is zoned “residential” to clear all flammable matter from the whole of the land except living trees, shrubs and plants under cultivation and lawns.
- B As to all other land within the district the owner or occupier shall—
- (i) Clear firebreaks of a minimum width of three (3) metres inside all external boundaries of the land; and
  - (ii) Clear firebreaks of a minimum width of five (5) metres around all buildings situated on the land; and
  - (iii) Where that area of land exceeds ten (10) hectares, clear firebreaks of a minimum width of five (5) metres so as to ensure that no area of land within the firebreaks exceeds ten hectares in land; and
  - (iv) In any event, clear the firebreaks to the satisfaction of Council’s duly authorised officer.

If for any reason an owner or occupier considers it to be impracticable to clear firebreaks or comply with other fire protection measures in accordance with this requirement, the owner or occupier may apply in writing to the Council’s duly authorised officer no later than 31 October 2011 for an exemption or partial exemption from compliance with the requirement of this notice.
