Notice of Amendment

Notice is hereby given that at a meeting of the Committee of the Western Australian Trotting Association held at Gloucester Park, East Perth, on the 13th day of January 1998, it was resolved by an absolute majority of the members of the Committee that the Rules of Trotting be amended as follows—

Delete existing Rules 298(b), 458 and 472 and replace with the following—

Approved Whip

- 298(b) The only approved whip for use is a swish whip with a core of whalebone or fibreglass, with an overall length inclusive of the keeper, of 1220 millimetres, and with a one piece leather keeper of not more than 60 millimetres in length and 20 millimetres in width.

Disobedience and Conduct Bringing Trotting into Disrepute

458. Any licensed or registered person who—
- (a) shall be guilty of any act of misconduct calculated to bring the sport of harness racing into disrepute; or
 - (b) shall disobey the reasonable order of the Stewards or an official of a Club acting in his official capacity or those officials whom they or it may appoint; or
 - (c) shall refuse to pay any fine which may be imposed on him,
- commits an offence and may be dealt with accordingly.

Whip Usage

472. When carrying or using a whip any reinsperson who, in the opinion of the Stewards—
- (a) draws the hand using the whip above the reinsperson's shoulder;
 - (b) allows the whip to project outside the confines of the reinsperson's sulky;
 - (c) allows the whip to obstruct, hinder, impede or interfere with any other reinsperson or horse;
 - (d) strikes or attempts to strike any other reinsperson or horse; or
 - (e) uses the whip after the reinsperson's horse has finally passed the winning post;
 - (f) uses the whip when the reinsperson's horse cannot improve or maintain its position, or when its run is finished;
 - (g) uses the whip excessively or in a manner likely to cause injury to the reinsperson's horse,
- commits an offence.
