#### PART IIIB—FISH PROCESSING

Fremantle Fishermans Co-operative is hereby authorised to establish a processing establishment to process Rock Lobster in pursuance of the provisions of Section 32C of the Fisheries Act 1905 at 22 Mews Road Fremantle, subject to the following—

1. Shall comply with the requirements of the Fisheries Act 1905-1975, and all regulations, Orders in Council, and Notices and Ministerial Directions issued thereunder.
2. Shall not be used for the processing of prawns.
3. Shall comply with the requirements of the Health Act 1911 (amended).
4. Shall comply with the requirements of any Town Planning Scheme or Interim Development Order gazetted under the provisions of the Town Planning and Development Act 1928 (amended) or the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act 1959 (amended).
5. Shall be registered as an export establishment pursuant to the provisions of the Parliament of the Commonwealth Export Control Act 1982, and orders made thereunder, more specifically the Prescribed Goods (General) Orders and the Fish Orders, should it be used to process fish for export.
6. Shall not be used for the processing of marron (*Cherax tenuimanus*) unless a licence is held under Section 39C of the Fisheries Act 1905-1975.
7. Rock lobster shall not be processed or received for processing on Christmas Day, New Year's and Good Friday.
8. Shall not be in possession or control, or have on any licensed premises any setose rock lobster or tarspot rock lobster.
9. Shall not sell or cause to be sold, offer or expose for sale any setose rock lobster or tarspot rock lobster.
10. Shall not be in possession or control, or have on any licensed premises any female western rock lobster with a carapace length greater than 115mm.
11. Shall not sell or cause to be sold, offer or expose for sale any female western rock lobster with a carapace length greater than 115mm.
12. Shall not accept from any person or have in possession on any licensed premises any female western rock lobster with a carapace length greater than 105mm which were taken from waters north of 30 degrees 48 minutes south latitude.

13. The licensee shall ensure—
- (i) that the rock lobster inspection facilities set out hereunder will be continuously available within the premises covered by this licence for use at any time by a Fisheries Officer;
  - (ii) that satisfactory arrangements are made to make containers of rock lobster selected by Fisheries Officers available for inspection as prescribed hereunder—
    - (a) An inspection table shall be provided and constructed such that the table top—
      - (i) is approximately 85cm from the floor,
      - (ii) is fitted with sides and ends sufficient to contain rock lobster
      - (iii) can hold two containers or rock lobster no more than two rock lobsters deep across the surface of the table; and
      - (iv) is fitted with a chute so the contents can be pushed from the table surface.
    - (b) facilities shall be available for basket holders on the inspection table.
    - (c) the area or areas set aside for inspection of lobsters shall be—
      - (i) sufficient in area to permit two Fisheries Officers to undertake inspections at the table simultaneously;
      - (ii) adequately lit and ventilated;
      - (iii) located close to the rock lobster receival section of the licensed premises;
      - (iv) adequate screened from spraying water or other materials; and
      - (v) free from excessive machinery noise.
    - (d) The contents of each bag selected or container of rock lobster shall be placed upon an inspection table by employees of the licensee and shall be removed from the table as necessary after inspection.
14. The granting of a licence for these premises to be dependant on the removal of processing licence 1041 from Seabird to Fremantle or the issue of a new licence in lieu of licence 1041.
15. Any expansion of processing capacity for other than live rock lobster processing to be subject to separate application.

To All Owners and Occupiers of Land within the City of Cockburn

Take notice that pursuant to the powers contained in section 33 of the above Act, you are hereby required on or before the 15th November 1995, to clear fire breaks of all Flammable material (which includes vegetation).
