- (a) resolutions without dissent;
  - (b) policies of insurance; and
  - (c) material delivered under section 49(3) by an original proprietor to a strata company at its first annual general meeting.

Furthermore, that the Closure of Waters will only apply between the hours of 1700 and 2030 on Thursday 26 January 2006 and is not applicable to those bona fide vessels or persons involved in approved aquatic events or associated with the Lotto Skyworks 2006.
