Hospitals and Health Services Act 1927

Hospitals (Services Charges) Regulations 1984

Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 2006

Made by the Minister for Health under section 37(3)(af) of the Act and regulation 5(2).

1. Citation

This determination is the Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 2006.

2. Application

This determination applies —

- (a) to all public hospitals other than day hospitals, nursing homes and nursing posts; and
- (b) with respect to
 - (i) private in-patients;
 - (ii) compensable in-patients;
 - (iii) ineligible in-patients;
 - (iv) private same day patients;
 - (v) compensable same day patients; and
 - (vi) ineligible same day patients.

3. Charges payable in respect of surgically implanted prostheses

- (1) In this clause
 - "Schedule" means the Schedule to the determination made under sections 73AAG(6) and 73AAG(7) of the *National Health Act 1953* of the Commonwealth;
 - "Scheduled Amount", in relation to a surgically implanted prosthesis specified in the Schedule, means the "Benefit Amount/Minimum Benefit Amount" set out in the Schedule for that prosthesis.

- (2) The charge payable in respect of the supply of a surgically implanted prosthesis
 - (a) specified in the Schedule under the heading "CARDIO-THORACIC" is 92.5% of the Scheduled Amount;
 - (b) specified in the Schedule under the heading "OPHTHALMIC" is 80% of the Scheduled Amount; and
 - (c) otherwise specified in the Schedule is the Scheduled Amount
- 4. Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 1994 revoked

The Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 1994 is revoked.

CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1971

ORDER PROHIBITING SUPPLY OF GOODS

- I, Patrick Walker, Commissioner for Fair Trading in and for the State of Western Australia-
 - being satisfied that a Consumer Affairs Authority namely John Lenders, the Minister for Consumer Affairs in and for the State of Victoria has by notice dated 19 January 2004 and published in the Victoria *Government Gazette* on 22 January 2004, made an Order or similar instrument ("the Corresponding Order") prohibiting the supply of goods described in the Schedule hereto; and
 - considering it necessary in the interests of the safety of the public;
 - Order pursuant to section 23R(3) of the Consumer Affairs Act 1971 that the supply to consumers of goods described in the Schedule is prohibited in this State; and
 - Further order that this Order shall take effect upon date of gazettal.

The Schedule

Objects, including but not limited to 'ice pipes' that are used, intended for use, or designed for use in smoking or inhaling into the human body methamphetamine crystals (also known by other names including 'ice' and 'crystal meth').

Explanatory Note

This order prohibits the supply of 'ice pipes' and similar products specifically used for smoking or inhaling methamphetamine crystals including 'crystal meth' or 'ice'. Methamphetamine causes increased heart rate and blood pressure and can cause irreversible damage to blood vessels in the brain, producing strokes. Its use can result in cardiovascular collapse and death.
