WHEREAS by section 11 of the Native Welfare Act, 1904-1960 it is provided that the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to cancel any

Crown Lands which have been declared a Reserve for Natives; and whereas it is deemed desirable that the Reserve for Natives at Lot 84, Highbury, should now be cancelled. Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby declare the Native Reserve at Lot 84, Highbury, to be cancelled.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 2 of the Railways (Cue-Big Bell and other Railways) Discontinuance Act, 1960, that the Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation, and that it shall not be necessary to proclaim that the whole of the Act shall commence on one day, but the several sections and paragraphs of the Act may be proclaimed to commence on such days as are respectively fixed by Proclamation; and whereas it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 11 of the Act that on and after the commencement of any paragraph of subsection (2) of that section the railway specified in that paragraph shall cease to be operated until the Governor otherwise declares; and whereas it is desired that the paragraph of subsection (2) of section 11 of the Act that is specified in this Proclamation shall commence: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor

and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix the day on which this Proclamation is published in the *Government Gazette* as the day on which paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 11 of the Railways (Cue-Big Bell and other Railways) Discontinuance Act, 1960, shall commence.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960, that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board, from time to time, and at any time, by Proclamation declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that the land described in the schedule hereunder be declared a totalisator agency region for those purposes: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that as from and including the 11th day of September, 1961, the land described in the schedule hereunder shall be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960.

Schedule.

All that portion of land comprising the area bounded by lines starting in Claremont at the point where an imaginary line in prolongation of the eastern boundary of Bay View Terrace in a southerly direction meets the high water mark of the right bank of the Swan River; thence along that high water mark in a westerly direction to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation of the eastern boundary of Queenslea Drive in a southerly direction; thence along that imaginary line in a northerly direction to the point of its merger with that eastern boundary; thence along that eastern boundary in the same direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the south-eastern boundary of Stirling Highway; thence across Stirling Highway to the point of the junction of its north-western boundary with the eastern boundary of Stirling Road; thence along that eastern boundary in a northerly direction across all streets meeting the same, by way of the subway beneath the railway between Perth and Swanbourne and continuing in the same direction across Claremont Crescent to the point where it meets the southern boundary of Shenton Road; thence along that southern boundary in a westerly direction across Stirling Road and all streets meeting that boundary to the point of its junction with the eastern boundary of Servetus Street; thence along that eastern boundary in a northerly direction across Shenton Road and all streets meeting that boundary to the point of its junction with the southern boundary of Alfred Road; thence along that southern boundary in a general easterly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the north-western boundary of Stubbs Terrace; thence across Stubbs Terrace along an imaginary line in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Alfred Road to the point where it meets the north-western boundary of the railway reserve of the railway hereinbefore in this schedule mentioned; thence along that

north-western boundary in a north-easterly direction to the point where it meets an imaginary line in prolongation westerly of the southern boundary of Onslow Road; thence along that imaginary line in an easterly direction across the said railway reserve and Railway Road to the point of its merger with the said southern boundary; thence along that southern boundary in the same direction to the point of its junction with the western boundary of Smyth Road; thence across Smyth Road to the point of the junction of its eastern boundary with the southern boundary of Onslow Road; thence along the eastern boundary of Smyth Road in a southerly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the northern boundary of Stirling Highway; thence across Stirling Highway in a southerly direction to the point of junction of its southern boundary with the western boundary of Webster Street; thence along that western boundary in the same direction across all streets meeting the same to its point of intersection with the northern boundary of Princess Road; thence along that northern boundary in a westerly direction across all streets meeting the same to the point of its junction with the eastern boundary of Bay View Terrace; thence along that eastern boundary in a southerly direction across Princess Road and all streets meeting that boundary to the point of its merger with the imaginary line first in this schedule mentioned; and thence along that imaginary line, in the same direction, to the starting point.
